Biography

Jeffrey C. Walker is ex-Chairman and CEO of CCMP Capital (CCMP). CCMP is the \$12 billion successor to JPMorgan Partners (JPMP), JPMorgan Chase & Co's global private equity group with operations in North America, Europe and Asia. He was previously also Vice Chairman of JP Morgan Chase & Co. and Chairman of the JPMorgan Foundation. Before co-founding JPMorgan Partners in 1984, Mr. Walker worked in the Investment Banking and Finance Divisions of Chemical Bank and the Audit and Consulting Divisions of Arthur Young & Co. Mr. Walker is a Certified Public Accountant and a Certified Management Accountant. He graduated with a BS from the University of Virginia and an MBA from the Harvard Business School.

He is a Director of 1-800-Flowers (Nasdaq-FLWS) and Harbor Point Reinsurance. He was previously Vice Chairman of the National Association of Small Business Investment Corporations served on other corporate boards including House of Blues, Parker Pen, Domain, Gymboree, Guitar Center, Tenax Corporation, Harris Chemicals, Six Flags Amusement Parks, Doane Pet Care, Axis Insurance, Backe Communications and Somerset Pharmaceuticals. He personally focused on retail, consumer, media/entertainment and financial services deals.

He received the 1998 Award for Excellence in Growth Capital Investing from the University of Michigan Business School and JPMorgan Partners was named to the Private Equity Hall of Fame by the Private Equity Analyst Publication.

Non-profit activities

Lecturer – Teaching a seminar on “High Impact Change Organizations (applying private equity techniques to the not for profit world)” during the Fall of 2008 and 2009 at the Center for Leadership at Harvard's Kennedy School (Master's Students).

NPower – Ex-Chairman (chair for seven years) and Founder and still on the board, a charity that provides technology training to inner city kids and finds them jobs and also provides technology back office for over 500 non-profits

Thomas Jefferson Foundation (Monticello) – Chairman for three years and currently Vice Chairman.

Millennium Promise – Chairman. Charity acting as an incubator for non-profit NGOs set up to support the achievement of the Millennium Development goals set by the UN. The major initiatives include the Millennium Villages (78 villages in 10 African countries which are being prototyped as sustainable development models), Malaria No More and Millennium Farms.

JPMorgan Chase Foundation – was Chairman of this Foundation which gave away over \$110 million a year around the world.

Big Apple Circus – ten years on the board. A non-profit touring circus where the proceeds go to support clown care units in 35 children's hospitals across the United States.

Morgan Library – on the Board and investment/endowment committee.

University of Virginia – on Campaign Executive Committee and the board of the Presidents Endowment (\$50 million). President of the McIntire School Foundation for ten years (the undergraduate business school). Am currently a trustee of the McIntire Foundation.

School Boards – was Chairman of the Wilton Public Schools in Wilton, CT. and served on the board of St. Lukes School in New Canaan, CT.

New York City Investment Fund – ex board member. \$120 million fund focused on bringing jobs to NYC and enhancing the city through supporting education and social services. Started by Henry Kravis (KKR) and Russ Carson (Welsh Carson).

Others – on the board of the Lincoln Center Film Society and Visiting Committee of the Harvard Business School.
