Ideal Candidates

- Harvard Business School MBA alumni within the last 7-10 years.
- Post-doctoral researcher in a Harvard research lab or Harvard-affiliated hospital within the first 5 years of completing their doctoral program.

Guidelines to consider when applying

- Receive \$100K stipend over 12 months and access to benefits.
- Apply for \$35K operating funds to support enterprise creation.
- Commit and attend regular Fellowship meetings and events from July 2021- June 2022.
- Work in the Pagliuca Harvard Life Lab (when permitted).
- Reside in the Boston area for more than 60% of the year.
- Preference given to applicants already working on a viable technology.
- Sign the Community Standards, Confidentiality, and IP agreements, if offered admission, available on www.hbs.edu/blavatnik.
